NRS 6.020 EXEMPTIONS FROM JURY DUTY

- , 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsections 2 and 3 and NRS 67.050, upon satisfactory proof, a grand or trial jurors:
 - (a) While the Legislature is in session, any member of the Legislature or any employee of the Legislature or the Legislative Counsel Bureau,
 - (b) Any person who has a fictitious address pursuant to NRS 217.462 to to 217.471, inclusive, and
 - (c) Any police officer as defined in NRS 617.135.
- All persons of the age of 70 years or over are exempt from serving as grand or trial jurors. Whenever it appears to the satisfaction of the court, by affidavit or otherwise, that a juror is over the age of 70 years, the court shall order the juror excused from all services as a grand or trial juror, if the juror so desires.
- 3. A person who is the age of 65 years or over who lives 65 miles or more from the court is exempt from serving as a grand or trial juror. Whenever it appears to the satisfaction of the court, by affadavit or otherwise, that a juror is the age of 65 years or over, and lives 65 miles or more from the court, the court shall order the juror excused from all services as a grand or trial juror, if the juror so desires.

6.202 PENALTY FOR FAILING TO ATTEND TO SERVE AS A JUROR. Any person summoned as provided in this chapter to serve as a juror, who fails to attend and serve as a juror, shall, unless excused by the court, be ordered by the court to appear to show cause for his failure to attend and serve as a juror. If he fails to show cause he is in contempt and shall be fined no more than \$500.
