

The Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) requires all state agencies to collect data for every allegation of sexual abuse at facilities under its direct control. The agency shall aggregate the data annually. The PREA definitions companion document can be reviewed for assistance.

The Douglas County Juvenile Detention has a **ZERO TOLERENCE** policy against all forms of sexual abuse and sexual harassment of any youth within the facility. This includes sexual abuse and / or sexual harassment against youth by other youth, staff, volunteers, contractors, visitors, or interns as defined within the Department of Justice Prison Rape Elimination (PREA) Standards, 28 CFR Part 115, Such conduct is punishable by administrative or disciplinary sanctions and / or criminal prosecution. (Prea Standard 115.311) The following juvenile court secure detention facility data related to sexual abuse is for calendar year 2022.


Intake procedures have become more streamlined with Tyler Supervision assessments.


Juvenile Detention is awaiting bid and IRC approval for new camera systems to be installed throughout the facility and lake jail. Additional cameras will be added to wings, rooms, hallways, dayroom and recyards.

Requests have been submitted and awaiting IRC approval for additional on-call staff to update staffing plan to include 2 staff 24 hours / day.

PREA Definitions Companion

<u>Substantiated allegation</u> means an allegation that was investigated and determined to have occurred.

<u>Unfounded allegation</u> means an allegation that was investigated and determined not to have occurred.

<u>Unsubstantiated allegation</u> means an allegation that was investigated and the investigation produced insufficient evidence to make a final determination as to whether or not the event occurred.

Nonconsensual Means without permission.

<u>Sexual abuse</u> Means contact, through clothing or directly, or display, between the penis, vulva, anus or mouth or finger, hand, object or other instrument.

Any attempt, threat, or request by a staff member, contractor, or volunteer to engage in any sexual misconduct or voyeurism.

<u>Voyeurism</u> by a staff member, contractor, or volunteer means an invasion of privacy of an inmate, detainee, or resident by staff for reasons unrelated to official duties, such as peering at an inmate who is using a toilet in his or her cell to perform bodily functions; requiring an inmate to expose his or her buttocks, genitals, or breasts; or taking images of all or part of an inmate's naked body or of an inmate performing bodily functions.

<u>Sexual harassment</u> Means repeated and unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, or verbal comments, gestures, or actions of a derogatory or offensive sexual nature by one inmate, detainee, a staff member, contractor, volunteer, or resident directed toward another.
